

Consultation. Global Reconnaissance Solutions, LLC offers a full range of on-site consultation services. It is our philosophy to work with your organization's decision makers to develop and foster a partnership to improve its ability to consider all aspects of overseas travel. Moreover, we want to help maximize the likelihood that your personnel will remain safe and effective while abroad. Consultation includes, but is not limited to, review and analysis of current organizational training for overseas movement, your organization's standard operating procedures, safety measures, voice & data methods, planning/reporting procedures, and finally current tactics, techniques and procedures employed by your organization as it pertains to emergency drills.

Duration: as required

Corporate Forward Element Training. The focus of this training is to help prepare small elements of the organization to set up and operate semi-permanently outside of the United States (usually targeting employees that will be gone for 30 or more consecutive days out to six months). Consideration is placed on operational issues, logistics support, communications, transportation & movement, medical considerations, corporate security, and anti-terrorism. Additionally, this training covers statements of work to facilitate the setup of a forward office abroad. Course instruction includes but is not limited to establishing the following contracts: hotel/apartment building to be used as an office, trash removal, office supplies, office furniture, car rental agreements, and more. This course is offered over an eight hour day with a break each hour plus one hour for lunch.

Execution Instructions. This class provides students with instructions on how to plan an overseas movement. It uses a five paragraph format: situation (background information on the country to which you will travel), mission (answering who, what, where, when and why), execution (with sub-tasks), administration & logistics, and finally, command & control. Students are provided with a sample report and conduct an in-class exercise developing a skeleton for organization-unique execution instructions. Situation Report. This class provides students with instructions on how to report on the status of their overseas progress. Either transmitted daily or by exception, the report attempts to encapsulate the key accomplishments of what transpired since the last report. It also looks to the future informing the home office of goals, priorities and objectives for the next reporting period. Trip Report. This class provides students with instructions on how to capture lessons that were learned while abroad to be used by the organization for future overseas operations. Moreover, it looks to capture what went well and what could be done better to improve future overseas ventures. The intent is for the organization to build a repository or database capturing comments from returning employees. “How To” for General Overseas Planning. This class provides students with the overall basic considerations for planning a work visit abroad. Emphasis is placed on airline reservations & seating considerations, ground movement (car rentals, maps, GPS, route planning, etc), hotel considerations (hotel, room and floor selection), documentation (travel visas, passports, etc), and more.

Land Mine Awareness. This class provides students with a cursory overview of landmines, their placement and telltale signs that mines might be present. Students also receive instruction on explosive hazard indicators and information on what to do if one suspects a land mine or

unexploded ordnance. Finally students receive a pictorial presentation of commonly used mines in today's contemporary operating environment.

Basics of Survival/Survival & Emergency Kit Consideration. This class provides students with a basic overview of what it takes to survive. Capitalizing on the unclassified US Defense Department survival tactics, techniques and procedures, students are provided basic information on survival. Classes are also provided on survival kit considerations and construction using six survival tenets (water, food gathering, shelter, navigation, fire and signal). Students are also advised on basic emergency kit construction grounded in the Department of Homeland Security's recommendations.

Passive Surveillance Techniques. Students are provided with basic instruction on how to determine if they are being followed either on foot or in a vehicle (using stakeout, pickup, follow and box phases of surveillance). Unlike active surveillance which looks to elicit a response from the tailing party, this class focuses solely on determining if a person or group is following you and to leverage host nation authorities and resources to put an end to it. Instruction is also provided on procedures to help minimize the likelihood of one becoming a target of surveillance from the start.

Principles of Listening Devices, Bugging and Principles of Technical Surveillance Counter Measure (TSCM) Sweeps. This class provides instruction to students on the principles of installing surveillance devices in static locations (hotel rooms and offices). Though not intended to make the student an expert in conducting counter listening devices activities (today's devices are extremely small and easy to conceal), the class will provide instruction on obvious signs that

someone has tampered with one's room or office. Basic battery operated and telephone installed devices are shown to the students.

Country / Threat Assessments. Students are provided with instruction on open sources of information for assessing the common threats existing in the country in which they will work. Understanding your operating environment is paramount for success. Emphasis is on collecting information well prior to travel to consider mitigating tactics, techniques and procedures to help reduce the likelihood that the student will become a victim of terrorism, kidnapping and/or crime.

Gray Man & Street Smart Procedures. Students are provided with information on blending in and how to maintain a "presence" to help reduce the likelihood that they will stand out, and by extension, become victims of negative circumstances while abroad. Essentially, Global Reconnaissance Solutions provides basic information on helping individuals look like they belong in different cultural settings. Focus also includes dress and techniques to help individuals not look "American" and easy targets respectively.

Basic Photography. Students are provided with basic photographic techniques and advised on digital camera types based on the experience level of the student (with regards to photography). Understanding that a picture provides greater insight into an environment than just a written report, this class seeks to help students get the most from their digital cameras. Though offered at the basic level, the instruction looks to provide a grounding in the basics (camera angles, rule of 3rds, and lighting) so that the pictures taken while abroad can be used and interpreted upon the student's arrival in the United States. Basics on common digital camera operating instructions are also covered.

Basic Videography (Route). Students are provided with basic instruction on the use of basic digital video cameras. Intended to capitalize on the basic photography course, this block of instruction helps the students use videography as a way to garner information on routes to allow for the organization to better assess the country's road infrastructure and driving conditions.

Anti-Terrorism Force Protection Route Planning. Students are provided with the basics on how to select viable routes (and alternate routes) in different environments. Course instruction also emphasizes route variation to facilitate the avoidance of target pattern analysis by nefarious individuals and groups. Emphasis is placed on knowing likely spots for the emplacement of ambushes and Improvised Explosive Devices.

Corporate Counter Espionage. Students are provided instruction in how to safeguard organizational material while abroad. Organizations not only have an open desire to keep their employees safe while overseas, but also want information about their organization kept under the control of their employees. Though no system is fool-proof, there are measures that can be employed to reduce the likelihood of proprietary information and other sensitive material falling into the wrong hands. Course content includes tactics, techniques and procedures used by intelligence collectors to steal information and techniques to minimize the success of their efforts.

Wireless Battery Operated Motion Sensors / Alarms (Safe House Configuration). Students are provided with instruction on how to use and install basic commercial-off-the-shelf alarm technology to be used in moderate risk environments. Alarm systems can serve as both an early warning system and as a procedure to help ward off unwelcome people. The intent is to teach student how to use complementary technology to augment existing physical security measures found in hotels and forward office locations.

Basics First Aid Considerations / Basic Medical Planning. Students are provided instruction on the importance of having a first aid kit and in having an executable first aid plan. Though not intended to be a panacea for all things medical, course content gravitates around the most basic considerations to at least encourage those travelling abroad to consider the importance of medical considerations. The basics include recommended first aid kit contents, the importance of having enough prescription medication on hand for the trip's duration and understanding the medical locations and capabilities of the foreign country in which one will operate.

Voice: Mobile (Tri-Band) Phones, Satellite Phone, FM Communications. Students are provided with a cursory overview of various voice systems, their strengths and limitations. The principles of each of these modes of communications are covered in this module. Moreover, the importance of redundancy is taught to help ensure continuity in communications. This module should be taken in conjunction with the data course.

Data: Free Encrypted Email, Manual Encryption, and Code Words/B-GAN Use. Students are provided with a cursory overview of various data systems, their strengths and limitations. The principles of each of these modes of communications are covered in this module. Students are also required to log onto an Internet terminal and establish a free encrypted email account. Basic cryptology is also covered as a way to safeguard information transmitted over non-secure networks. Moreover, the importance of redundancy is covered to help ensure continuity in communications. This module should be taken in conjunction with the voice course.

Introduction to Encryption (Cipher Wheel, Single Pad and Code Word Methods). Students are provided with instruction on how to use code in order to manually encrypt words and data to help protect information during voice and data transmission. Ideally this course should be taken in conjunction and preceding both the voice and data classes. A practical exercise is administered with this class to help reinforce the lesson.

IED. Students are provided with instruction on the basics of Improvised Explosive Devices (IEDs), their emplacement and ways they are triggered. IEDs are often a tactic of choice in today's world. They provide the enemy both stand-off (facilitating their egress) and high payoff for relatively little cost. Emphasis is placed on telltale signs of emplacement and preferred locations for detonation. This course is designed to enhance lessons learned in the Anti-Terrorism Force Protection Route Planning course.

Ambush. Students are provided instruction on the tactics, techniques and procedures behind the emplacement and initiation of ambushes. Emphasis is placed on likely ambush locations so that students can avoid, where possible, such locations. This course is designed to enhance lessons learned in the Anti-Terrorism Force Protection Route Planning course.

Sniper. Students are provided instruction on the tactics, techniques and procedures behind the emplacement and initiation of sniper fire. Emphasis is placed on likely ambush locations so that students can avoid, where possible, such locations. This course is designed to enhance lessons learned in the Anti-Terrorism Force Protection Route Planning course.

Indirect Fire. Students are provided instruction on the tactics, techniques and procedures behind the use of indirect fire. Like the Improvised Explosive Devices, indirect fire is a great stand off weapon providing the enemy with time and distance to move out of the area as he or she attempts to escape. Though not a common technique used today, it complements the repertoire of other courses (IED, ambush and sniper). This course is designed to enhance lessons learned in the Anti-Terrorism Force Protection Route Planning course.
